CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please contact the Fair Office if you have a medical condition requiring assistance.

Return this application to the Fair Office by July 9, 2022

\$25.00 late fee if this permit is received after July 10, 2022

No refunds will be given for cancellations after July 24, 2022

1. Spaces will be pre-assigned by the Campground Superintendent. Please check-in upon arrival at the Fair Office to pick-up your camping paperwork and space assignment. The Camping Superintendent has the authority to have vehicles towed and request the removal of disruptive or unruly campers.
2. Admissions passes to the Fair will be required and are not included in the fee for camping space(s).
3. Campers may move in beginning Saturday, July 30th from 11:00 am to 6:00pm and/or on Sunday, July 31st from 11:00am to 6:00pm.
4. All vehicles and RVs must display the campground permit provided. Vehicles without permits will be towed at the owner's expense.
5. Campground speed limit is 5mph. This is strictly enforced. Fire lanes **must be kept open** at all times. Vehicles blocking fire lanes will be towed at owner's expense.
6. Persons under the age of 18 will not be allowed to camp independently. An adult must be at the campsite when children are present.
7. All youth must be in their own campsite nightly by curfew.
8. Your permit allows for 1 campsite and 1 vehicle 'camping' parking permit. Your camper and vehicle **MUST FIT** within your assigned space. Including awnings and tip outs Vehicles that cannot fit within campsite boundaries must purchase an additional space (if available).
9. For vehicles that don't fit within the camping space an additional space can be purchased if space allows. Parking passes for 'Day Parking' can be obtained at the Fair Office.
10. Hay and Straw cannot be stored in the campground due to Fire Marshall Regulations.
11. Courteous respect for other campers is expected. Quiet time is from Fair closing until 7:00am. The Fair closes at 12:00am on Friday and Saturday and 10:00pm all other days.
12. The following are **NOT** allowed in the campground or on the grounds at any time:
 - ✓ Firearms
 - ✓ Pets
 - ✓ Open Fires
 - ✓ Waste water dumping
13. The Fire Marshall has approved using Propane/Pellet BBQ's to cook on.
14. All Campsites must be vacated within 24 hours of the close of the Fair. Anything left more than 24 hours will be removed at the registered occupants' expense.

Campground Fees: Power & Water Space (determined by lottery) \$24/night

Dry RV Space \$12/night Tent Space \$6/night

Note: Should a shortage of camping spaces occur, consideration will be given to those traveling the furthest.
